***Organizers to Resume Courthouse Petition Drives;
County admits Earth Day Free Speech "Confusion"***

SACRAMENTO -- Moments ago, RecallMcBrien.Org Committee Members, under consultation with their attorneys and an apology from Sacramento County court administrators, have decided as one part of their overall strategy to remove Judge Peter McBrien from the bench, to continue their recall petition gathering efforts at the William Ridgeway Family Relations Courthouse. Though we are awarding a contract to one or more seasoned private petition gathering companies, "protecting our constitutional free speech rights at the family law courthouse is a symbolic and strategic right that we will protect in its entirety." proclaimed Ulf Carlsson, one of the recall organizers.

On Earth Day, April 22, 2008, RecallMcBrien.Org recall petition gathering efforts were illegally compromised by Sacramento court administrators and the Sacramento Sheriffs department. On Friday April 25, 2008, RecallMcBrien.Org lawyers immediately sent a 'firm but fair' letter to Family Relations Courthouse Director of Operations Julie Setzer.

On Tuesday April 29, 2008 Jake Chatters, Deputy Director of Courts contacted recall attorneys and admitted that during the Earth Day event, there was "some confusion" among court and sheriff administrators.

It is the hope of RecallMcBrien.Org that no further legal action will be needed.
