**RECALL AGAINST SACRAMENTO FAMILY LAW
JUDGE PETER J. MCBRIEN LAUNCHED
Website "RecallMcBrien.Org" Goes Live!**

SACRAMENTO, CA. -- Backed by a growing list of passionate supporters, the Recall McBrien Committee formally announced today at a California State Capitol press conference, that they are leading an effort to recall Judge Peter J McBrien from the bench. The recall campaign was launched this morning with the unveiling of the website, www.RecallMcBrien.Org, which will serve as the online hub for collecting contributions to finance the recall effort, recruitment of volunteers, and organization of the signature gathering process.

The preliminary stages of the recall effort will focus on raising funds and organizing a volunteer force in preparation to begin the signature-gathering process to qualify the recall. Organizers will be reaching out to community leaders and the Sacramento public in order to build support for the recall across the local spectrum.

"I am starting this recall drive after determining that there must be a broad-based and multi-level effort that will have the credibility to qualify the recall for the ballot. *As it stands right now, we need leadership to educate and unite the community as to why this terrible judge must go,*" declared Ulf Carlsson, one of the many victims of Judge McBrien.

Carlsson, who's family law appellate case will be heard this coming Monday, continued by promising to "aggressively lead those who are disaffected in a sweeping recall effort that will send the message to the Sacramento Family Law system: you and bad judges like McBrien who have practiced years of personal and professional deliberate indifference WILL be held accountable for injuring citizens like myself and others."

For the next several weeks the Recall Judge Peter McBrien effort will focus on organizing and recruiting the hundreds of volunteers needed to collect the requisite 30,000 valid signatures to qualify the recall measure on the ballot.

"The recall process is something that should be reserved for only the most serious cases of malfeasance on the bench. **Unfortunately Judge Peter McBrien's conduct far surpasses the standards necessary to justify a recall.** It's not a question of whether we should recall Peter McBrien, it's an issue of how long can we afford to wait – all the while watching Sacramento residents who have the misfortune of having their cases assigned to his courtroom, slide further into the abyss," concluded Donald Tenn, nationally known fathers for justice advocate and supporter of the recall effort.
